Education in fisherman community is always neglected. To generate interest among the children of the fishermen community cash award incentive to the pass outs of HSC examination will be provided for higher education after admission in to the course during 2020-21.

SCHEME OUTLAY & ASSISTANCE:

Sl No	Percentage of marks secured in HSC examination	Cash award (In Rs.)
1	70% and above	7500/-
2	60% and above up to 69%	5000/-
3	50% and Above up to 59%	3000/-

BENEFICIARY SELECTION:

- The child of the fisherman shall submit application in plain paper with copy of HSC Pass certificate and mark sheet and College Admission receipt through Asst. Fisheries Officers / Block Development Officer of the Block conceded to the District Fisheries Officers
- The verification will be entrusted to the respective AFO or field functionaries who will verify the genuineness of the certificate ascertaining from the respective Headmaster of the School.
- The Head Master of the High School will submit the list of eligible students to Asst. Fisheries Officers to facilitate selection
