Sl. No.	Name of Scheme	Description
1.	Strengthening of Orissa Biological Product Institute (OBPI)	<p>Objective: To Produce Veterinary Biologicals for preventive vaccination of livestock and poultry birds.</p> <p>Salient Features: Production of Veterinary biological and supply to field institutions for timely vaccination against various contagious diseases in livestock and birds.</p>
2.	Up-Gradation of Livestock Health Care Services	<p>Objective: To provide essential medicines for curative treatment of animals.</p> <p>Salient Features: Medicines for field veterinary institutions, Animal health camps, deworming camps are provided.</p>
3.	Up-gradation of Skill in Self Employment under ARD Sector	<p>Objective: To organize training programme for developing the basic skills amongst the livestock holders and unemployed educated youths for taking up animal husbandry activities for self employment.</p> <p>Salient Features: In all blocks, training of farmers on Dairy/ Goat & Sheep/ Poultry farming in batches of 20 farmers are organized.</p>
4.	Utilization of Crop Residues	<p>Objective: To enrich the crop residue for better utilization and preservation of seasonal excess fodder for the lean period.</p> <p>Salient features: In Dairy intensive areas, demonstration is made on enrichment / ensiling of crop residue for preservation of excess seasonal fodder.</p>
5.	Training & Demonstration in Fodder cultivation and Pasture Development	<p>Objective: To transfer the technology at farmer's level through on-farm demonstration and training.</p> <p>Salient features: Departmental fodder farms are strengthened for production of perennial root slips, certified seeds. Farmers are trained at Farm level to adopt modern practices for fodder crop production.</p>

6.	Strengthening the Livestock Service Infrastructure & Modernisation of Offices	<p>Objective: To create basic infrastructure for providing referral Veterinary diagnostic services.</p> <p>Salient features: upgradation of Sub-Divisional level Veterinary Hospitals with modern diagnostic facilities is done.</p>
7.	Opening of New LAC	<p>Objective: To construct new Livestock Aid Centres in the Gram Panchayat, where no veterinary institution is available to provide basic veterinary services to the livestock owners.</p> <p>Salient features: New building with all furniture, equipments are provided for establishment of new LAC.</p>
8.	Organization of Exhibition for Buyer & Seller Meet	<p>Objective: to Establish direct contact between producer, buying agents, processor and users associated in livestock activities.</p> <p>Salient features: Cattle exhibition are organized in the districts and state level during Gosambardhana Week/ Adivasi Mela/ Krishi Mahotshab to make the people aware on livestock production, management.</p>
9.	Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) for ARD	<p>Objective: To strengthen infrastructures of Livestock Service Institution functioning under the ARD Sector such as Modernization of Orissa Biological Product Institute and creation of Infrastructure towards disease diagnosis for growth of the livestock & poultry sector.</p> <p>Salient features: Infrastructure projects are undertaken for strengthening of the OBPI, Referral disease diagnostic laboratory etc.</p>
10.	Strengthening of Dairy Organisation	<p>Objective: To streamline livestock breeding operations in the State.</p> <p>Salient Features: Equipments, critical inputs for Artificial Insemination in Cattle & Buffalo, Strengthening of bull mother farms are taken up.</p>

11.	Conservation and improvement of threatened indigenous breeds	<p>Objective: To Preserve and improve valuable local native germ-plasm steps like selective breeding for in-situ preservation is carried out so as to prevent from further dilution of their genetic potentiality.</p> <p>Salient features: Breeders' Forums are constituted to improve and conserve native breeds like Binjharpuri, Motu, Khariar and Ghumusari (Cattle Breed), Chilika and Kalahandi (Buffalo Breed) breeds. Survey and characterization of native breeds of Sheep/ Goat/ Poultry will be taken up.</p>
12.	Encouragement of commercial poultry entrepreneur and Promotion of Backyard Poultry Production	<p>Objective: To encourage commercial poultry entrepreneurs of the State to expand and set up new poultry farms.</p> <p>Salient Features: Reimbursement of VAT on poultry feed ingredients is made. The departmental poultry & duck breeding farms are provided with assistance to rear parent stock layer birds for production of hatching eggs of low input technology birds. Grant in aid will be provided for revival of the societies.</p>
13.	Genetic up-gradation of small animals	<p>Objective: To upgrade the indigenous Sheep, Goat & Pig to enhance the productivity.</p> <p>Salient Features: It is proposed to expand four Goat Breeding Farm, one Pig breeding Farm & one Sheep Breeding Farm of the State. Pure stock of locally suitable breeds like Black Bengal & Ganjam is reared in State farms. Selective breeding of indigenous stock with improved stock for genetic up gradation are taken up to upgrade the existing stock.</p>
14.	Strengthening of Disease Surveillance by Animal Disease Research Institute	<p>Objective: To control / prevent the contagious diseases of livestock and poultry having economic and zoonotic importance through conduction of routine surveillance.</p> <p>Salient features: Procurement of Laboratory chemicals, reagents, instruments and equipments , preparation and maintenance of disease epidemiological data, analysis of data compilation of OB reports, publication of disease surveillance bulletins are taken up.</p>

15.	Strengthening of Training Infrastructure under ARD Sector	<p>Objective: To update the knowledge and skill of the field veterinary staff.</p> <p>Salient features: Training infrastructure along with In-service training of Vets & Paravets are taken up.</p>
16.	Information, Education & Communication Programme	<p>Objective: To sensitise and educate livestock owners regarding modern practices on livestock rearing</p> <p>Salient features: Mass media such as Folk Dance, music, Pala Daskathia, Pathapranta Natak is used for dissemination of useful information. Zilla Kala Sanshkruti Sangha (ZKSS) & Block Kala Sanshkruti Sangha (BKSS) are also involved for sensitizing the livestock owners.</p> <p>Documentary films are prepared on livestock management for showing in public places and direct broad cast is being made through Gramsat programme.</p>
17.	Assistance to "KALYANI" Project through BAIF Development Research Foundation	<p>Objective: to provide gainful self-employment to the rural livestock keepers through dairy and livestock development programmes.</p> <p>Salient features: Door step livestock services are provided to the rural livestock keepers to breed the local cows by using superior dairy breeds like Jersey, Holstein Friesian & its crosses. Fodder demonstration plots have been raised in farmers' field with organization of azola pits and UTPS demonstration units. Chaff cutters and feeding troughs have been provided to farmers.</p> <p>Under goat development programme, 250 villages have been covered involving about 20,000 farm families. Breeding bucks have been provided to the goat keepers for genetic upgradation of their stock. Goats have been dewormed and vaccinated against PPR and Goat Pox.</p>

18.	Promotion of Dairy Entrepreneurship (PDE)	<p>Objective: to promote dairy entrepreneurs through provision of capital subsidy of 25% (General) and 33.33 % (SC & ST) for establishment of Dairy units.</p> <p>Salient Features: Dairy entrepreneurs are getting back ended subsidy through Bank for establishment of small dairy units with crossbred cows and buffaloes of Unit Size - 2 to 10 animals with a project cost of 1-5 lakhs.</p>
19.	Interest Subvention on Short Term Credit support for Dairy Farmers	<p>Objective: To facilitate credit linkage for dairy farmers to avail working capital loan.</p> <p>Salient Features: Farmers pursuing Dairy Farming as an income generating activities and availing short term loan are eligible for loan at subsidized rate of interest of 5 % and additional 3 % interest subvention will be made for prompt repayment of installments in due time.</p>
20.	Interest Subvention on Long Term credit support for dairy farmers	<p>Objective: To facilitate credit linkage for dairy farmers to avail term loan.</p> <p>Salient Features: Interest subvention of 3% of the interest rate is provided on term loan availed by the dairy farmers. Further, additional 2 % interest subvention will be made for prompt repayment of installments in due time.</p>
