### NOTIFICATION

The 3rd May, 2012

**S.R.O.No.236/2012**— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Odisha is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Orissa Veterinary Service, Class-II (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1987, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called Orissa Veterinary Service, Class-II (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Amendment Rules, 2012.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Odisha Gazette*.
2. In the Orissa Veterinary Service, Class-II (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1987 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 2 –
  - (i) after Clause (b), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(b-1) “Ex-servicemen” means persons as defined in the Orissa Ex-servicemen (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1985;”;
  - (ii) after Clause (d), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(d-1) “Persons with Disabilities” means persons who have been granted with disability certificates by Competent Authority as per the provisions of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Right and Full Participation) Orissa Rules, 2003;”;
  - (iii) after Clause (e), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(e-1) “SEBC” means the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes of citizens as defined in clause (e) of Section 2 of the Orissa Reservation of Vacancies for Posts and Services (for Socially and Educationally Backward Classes) Act, 2008;” and
  - (iv) after Clause (f), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(f-1) “Sportsmen” means persons who have been issued with identity card as sportsmen by the Director, Sports as per Resolution No.24808/Gen., Dated the 18th November, 1985 of General Administration Department;”.

3. In the said rules, in Rule 3, sub-rule (1) shall be substituted by the following sub-rule; namely:-

“(1) The service shall consists of the posts mentioned in Schedule appended to these rules.”.

4. In the said rules, in rule 4 –

(i) sub-rule (1) shall be substituted by the following sub-rule; namely:-

“(1) Appointment to the service shall be made by direct recruitment through competitive examination conducted by the Commission.”;

(ii) sub-rule (2) shall be substituted by the following sub-rule; namely:-

“(2) The Government shall normally assess in January each year the number of vacancies in the service to be filled up during that year. The assessment made and those likely to occur during the particular year and communicate the same to the Commission to undertake the recruitment process;” and

(iii) sub-rules (3) and (4) shall be deleted.

5. In the said rules, in Rule 6, Clause (d) shall be substituted by the following clause; namely:-

“(d) have attained the age of 21 years and must not be above the age of 32 years:

Provided that the upper age limit in respect of reserved categories of candidates referred to in Rule 19 shall be relaxed in accordance with the provisions of the Act, rules, orders or instructions, for the time being in force, for the respective categories.”.

6. In the said rules, Rule 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 shall be deleted.

7. In the said rules, Rule 19 shall be substituted by the following rule; namely:-

“19. Reservations – Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules reservation of vacancies or posts, as the case may be, for –

(a) Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the Orissa Reservation of Vacancies in Posts and Services (for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) Act, 1975 and the rules made thereunder; and

(b) SEBC, women, sportsmen, Ex-servicemen and Persons with Disabilities shall be made in accordance with the provisions made under such Acts, rules, orders or instructions issued in this behalf by the Government from time to time.”

8. In the said Rules, in rule 20, sub-rule (3) shall be deleted.

9. In the said Rules, rule 21 shall be substituted by the following rule; namely:–

“21. Probation – (1) Every person appointed to the post shall be on probation for a period of two years from the date of joining the post:

Provided that the appointing authority may, if think fit in any case or class of cases, extend the period of probation:

Provided further that such period of probation shall not include –

- (a) extraordinary leave;
- (b) period of unauthorized absence; or
- (c) any other period held to be not being on actual duty.

(2) The appointment of a probationer may for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded in writing, be terminated by Government at any time without previous notice during the period of probation including extension of such period, if any.”.

10. In the said rules, Schedule–I shall be substituted by the Schedule appended to these rules.
